2022 GOALS AND OUTCOMES

GROW THE ECONOMY by securing business investment and job creation

- Secure business investment:
 - Make measurable progress toward year-end 2023 goals of:
 - \$1 billion+ in business capital investment
 - 10,000 jobs
 - 150+ business attraction and local expansion projects
 - Focus on targeted sectors, including:
 - innovation-driven (autonomy and robotics, cybersecurity, life sciences and financial services)
 - industrial (additive and advanced manufacturing, climate tech, distribution and energy)

GALVANIZE INCLUSIVE REGIONAL ENGAGEMENT to enhance vitality for all

- Implement Inclusive Growth Principles to assure that diversity, equity and inclusion guide our decision making
 - Connect demographic and geographic support organizations to catalytic projects to pursue inclusive growth
- Make catalytic investments in real estate and people
 - Support the 16 communities in our Strengthening Communities Partnership, providing technical assistance and helping them secure private sector investment
 - Advance minority entrepreneurship and community development:
 - Black Economic Advancement Mobility: Serve as the fiscal agent and partner for new initiatives to identify, invest in, and support promising minority and women-owned businesses
 - Strategic Investment Fund: Recapitalize third round of the fund with refined strategic focus

- Develop and launch a regional talent marketing initiative to grow high-demand talent and workforce
 availability by mobilizing regional partners and Regional Investors to support joint-talent marketing and
 engagement strategies, including:
 - A college student retention and attraction initiative
 - Pittsburgh Passport Summer Program
 - A remote worker integration strategy
 - New ecosystem-supporting businesses to improve the elevation and engagement of diverse talent

UNLOCK THE REGION'S POTENTIAL by improving competitiveness, removing policy barriers and securing transformative public sector investment

- Create a more competitive business tax structure
 - Achieve material, immediate reduction of the CNI to 7.9% with a continued phase down based on performance metrics and increase or eliminate the cap on Net Operating Loss Carryforward
- Secure federal infrastructure investment in physical and digital connectivity
 - **\$800** million in federal waterways investment to complete a set of locks and dams
 - Demonstrate progress securing funding for 6 priority projects including the following:
 - Access to Hazelwood Green
 - Additional investment in the Upper Ohio Navigation System
 - ALCOSAN Clean Water Plan
 - Region-wide broadband and 5G expansion
 - Port Authority of Allegheny County Priority Projects
 - Laurel Valley Transportation Improvement Program
- Define and unveil strategy to revitalize Downtown Pittsburgh in partnership with Pittsburgh Downtown Partnership
- Build out key clusters in energy and robotics/autonomy to create jobs
 - Energy: Finalize and implement framework for region's transition to diverse, low-carbon energy future.
 - Identify regional leaders to drive implementation of decarbonization levers at scale
 - Build regional consensus to galvanize support for energy transition
 - Design and support policies and regulations at local, state and federal levels to aid safe, equitable and expedient deployment of decarbonization solutions
 - Pursue government funding to finance build-out of critical decarbonization infrastructure
 - Robotics/Autonomy: Secure up to \$100 million of Build Back Better investment and advance autonomy/AV policies
 - Pursue Competes Act inclusion as a Tech Hub
- Develop plan to reform state and local permitting so that key permit times are reduced
