

Chris Lohse is the innovation & technology manager for GAIN. In this role, he serves as the main interface between the U.S. Department of Energy's National Laboratories and the advanced reactor vendors. Chris is also the primary contact for the GAIN Nuclear Energy Voucher Program.
