

Douglas E. Wolfe is the associate vice president for Research, director of strategic initiatives (AVPR-SI) within the Office of the Senior Vice President for Research (OSVPR) at Penn State. The role of associate vice president for research, director of strategic initiatives, serves as a key member of the research leadership team and works in partnership with other leaders to implement research priorities and oversee portions of the institution's research administration and infrastructure. In this role, Wolfe works with the interim senior vice president for Research and members of the University Research Council to support faculty in their pursuits of extramural funding for strategic research; and oversees the Strategic Interdisciplinary Research Office (SIRO) in support of larger, externally funded interdisciplinary research proposals. Among other responsibilities, he provides leadership and OSVPR representation on internal and external task forces and committees on behalf of the Office of the Senior Vice President for Research to develop recommendations for addressing challenges and opportunities impacting Penn State Research, including managing the strategic plan implementation and delivery process.
